## Swimming Report

This season DVE swimmers continued to enjoy success in the competition pool and represented with distinction at school, district, state, national and international level. As a club we have proven once again that the quality of the squad program can match it with that of much larger and better resourced clubs.

I would like to thank the following people who have worked on the swimming sub committee all year to support the DVE swimming fraternity: Deb Kinder, Anne- Maree Somers, Michelle Piaia, Paul Piaia, Brian Miller, Martin Hone and Suzi Ilioski. I would also like to acknowledge the dedication of the coaches who work so hard to get the best out of individual swimmers under the leadership of Brian: Adele Bothma, Isobel Sproule, Lachie Trudgen and Suzi Dowsett. Also supported on occasion by Jessica Adams.

Our numbers have remained relatively stable through the season and currently sit at 95 squad members.

Some swimming highlights were:

- The number of qualifiers for major events included--14 at State SC Championships, 10 at State Open Championships, 23 at State Sprints, 3 at SC Nationals, 17 at Vic Age Championships and 10 at Vic Open Championships.
- We had eight representatives at the Hancock Prospecting National Age Championships, six of whom qualified for their first National event. Of these two made it onto the podium. Congratulations to Tara, Semra, Sofia, Declan, Alex, Brooke, Alanah and Bianca for qualifying for the highest level of age group representation the country offers. We also had the excitement of DVE being able to field a number of relays at a national competition for the very first time. Jackson also swam at the National Open Championship the week prior.
- Tara Kinder, Sera Olowoniyi, Alanah Ilioski and Alex Basile were selected onto various Swimming Victoria Development squads as a result of their achievements.
- Declan represented at Team Vic National Swimming Championships in Tasmania.
- Alanah and Semra were selected to represent Victoria at the inaugural Tri Series competition
- Maddi Fox representing at the World Down Syndrome Swimming Championships in Canada
- Tara Kinder represented at the Junior Pan Pacific Swimming Championships in Fiji and has been selected to swim at the World Junior Championships in August in Budapest.
- Brian was recognised by Swimming Victoria at their annual awards night for having a swimmer on an Australian team and continues as a coach for SV Development programs. Brian has also been selected as a coach to travel to Budapest with the World Junior team.
- We ran four successful qualifying meets and I would like to acknowledge here our technical officials who continue to give of their time so willingly to support grass roots swimming- Ken, Bob, Pat, Lindsay and Martin.
- Ally, Dylan and Jackson took part in SV's Developing Young Leaders Program
- Life member Lindsay Ellis reaching the milestone of 50 years involvement with swimming.

Swimming Australia introduced a new national swimming platform this season which replaces Club lane. As with all technological changes of this magnitude, it has not been without its challenges and problems. The process of working through these has been enormously time consuming and I would like to acknowledge Bob Oldfield's support and perseverance with SV as we continue to understand this system.

This season we made the decision to end the dryland program that was run from Watermarc. Our thanks to Jessica Adams for taking this program for 18 months and her contribution to the

success of our athletes during the season. DVE has now partnered with AV High Performance Academy in Bundoora where a professional strength and conditioning coach oversees a specific swim focused program for our athletes. Thank you to Adam Veli for his enthusiasm and willingness to support them.

I would like to acknowledge those of you who helped through the year in various activities in support of the club- whether you time kept, coached, organised volunteers, cooked the sausages at the BBQ's, cheered from the stands, officiated at meets, provided food for events, organised activities, acted as chauffeur or simply provided an ear for another, your contribution was much appreciated and valued. As we look to the new season, I encourage you all to consider again how best you could contribute to the functioning of the club.

Finally, thank you to Belgravia Watermarc for their ongoing support of DVE.

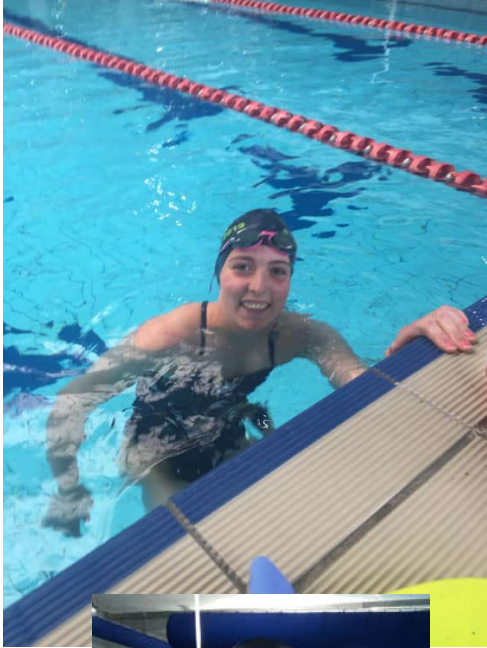

## Registrar's Report

Overall registrations for the year showed a very slight decrease compared with the previous season with total membership reducing by 4. The main reduction was amongst competitive swimmers with registrations down by 15. There was also a slight reduction in the number of water polo players and divers, but this was compensated by fewer multi activity members (swimming and water polo) and an increase in non playing water polo registrations.

There was also a change in the age group membership with an increase (12) in the number of members under the age of 12; this was compensated by a reduction in members (13) in the 13 to 17 years age group. Membership in the older age groups (18 plus) remained pretty consistent.

The mix of male to female membership remained almost the same as the prior season.

Membership breakdown is shown on a separate page along with a comparison with last season.

The total registrations for each of our main activities Swimming, Diving, and Water Polo are shown. There is then a 'netting' factor to take account of members who have registered in more than one activity. For example 16 competitive swimmers also registered as Water polo players. 74 new members joined the club whilst 81 did not renew their membership from the previous season.

## Financial Summary to 30 June 2019

The Finance Co-ordinator's role is to ensure that the clubs transactions are accurately reflected, and in this end I have been ably assisted by Chris Mahar, Pat Southwell, Leanne Giannios, Sharon Jones and Kasey Lawrence.

The final financial statements for DVE Aquatic Club (ABN 652 303 668 72) for the financial year ended 30 June 2019 are attached (subject to financial audit).

Overall the club has recorded a loss of \$6,757 for the year ended 30 June 2019.

The financial result of the swimming program is an overall loss of \$31,599 (after swim meet profits). The cost of running the swimming squad program continues to be more than the fees we are charging squad swimmers. Squad fees increased by approximately 7.5% from 1<sup>st</sup> February 2019, which has reduced the loss (by \$3,736) year on year in running this program. Overall squad revenue has decrease from the prior year (\$6,084). The profits generated from the numerous swim meets held during the year (\$49,964) has significantly offset the loss on the squad program.

Fundraising and financial sponsorships and grants we received this year (\$21,649), although generous, were less than last year (-\$7,290). These funds provide significant financial support to the club, particularly the swimming program. After consideration of fundraising and sponsorships, swimming continues to lose approximately \$12,500 per year. On this basis, swimming fees would need to increase by approximately 11% to remain viable.

Water polo has continued to record a surplus, this year \$6,896.

The diving division has traded at a loss of \$1,327.

There have been no significant financial transactions for lifesaving.

Other Activities such as presentation nights, functions, timing equipment rental, etc. was almost cost neutral resulting in a minor income of \$567. Of note, customer deposits (\$3,578) are largely related to the hire of club timing equipment. They are normally rolled over each year to cover the security deposit for the annual hire of the equipment, however these funds are technically payable at the end of each use.

The club has a positive cash position, at 30 June 2019, with a net cash balance of \$51,399.18.

The club continues to be in a strong financial position, however we need to make fundraising and sponsorship income a priority to ensure swimming program is financially independent.
