Swimming Report

We started the 21/22 season just like we did the year before, in another lockdown, and this one lasted until Mid-October. By this time, we had been in lockdown on and off for 263 days, that's at least 263 days without swimming but luckily October 2021 was the last of them.

The pools were very slow to reopen so the last 2 weeks of October the kids spent swimming outdoors at the Diamond Creek outdoor pool. Who can forget the frost in the morning where it was warmer in the water than out, and one squad even got to enjoy a thunderstorm nearby before they were evacuated. Either way the kids were happy just to get back to some kind of swimming and the coaches took it easier on them.....for a while.

Luckily, we still managed to hold 3 DVE meets, November 2021, May, and July this year. The income from these has been great for the club and we rely on them to survive, and I'd like to thank everyone who volunteered not only to organise the meets but who volunteered on the day.

We were also able to hold a few Club Nights on Wednesday nights which were great nights for kids to spend some time out of the water to get to know each other and get some race practice in.

In December we welcomed a new junior coach in Brooke Thwaites who also swims in the National Squad and has been doing a great job training the Development and Progressive squads with Suzi.

In January they held the Victorian Sprint Championships after being cancelled in August. 14 swimmers went in to race and there were PB's all around. With some newbies to the State Championships, they handled themselves like pro's getting top ten in their races.

In February DVE participated in the STARLIGHT SUPERSWIM. After 4 weeks of sessions, the kids clocked nearly 100 kms and raised \$580 and we thank everyone for their support not only to the kids who swam the laps but those who donated.

A month later Alex Basile flew back to Adelaide to compete in the Australian Open Swimming Championships and competed in the 100m Butterly with the pro's. Well done Alex!

I want to thank everyone for what was a very difficult year to begin with for our swimmers and parents. The lockdowns, restrictions, vaccine mandates and juggling of competitions and training schedules has made it very hard for our swimmers to consistently work on their goals and milestones but I want to thank everyone for sticking in there with the club. Like every sport we have had our challenges but the soul of DVE has remained and we will continue to grow next year and concentrate on the things we can



control and be flexible around the hurdles that are put in front of us.


Kids came out of lockdown and swam at Diamond Creek outdoor pool for 2 weeks.

Registrar's Report

For a second year in a row the season was disrupted by lockdowns caused by Coronavirus which in particular delayed the start of the water polo season. Active swimming registrations were only 3 fewer than the previous season but active water polo registrations were 15 fewer than last year. There was also a slight reduction in the number of registered divers. The number of Swimming 'Dry members', comprised of parents/guardians/Life members, and coaches, reduced from the prior season but there was a slight increase in the number of water polo volunteers. A total of 268 members registered across all disciplines a reduction of 23 from the previous season.

The largest fall in numbers was in the 12 and under age group which fell by 15 members and the over 21 age group which fell by 10. There was a slight increase in registrations in the 13 to 17 years age group. A total of 89 males registered in the under 21 age group compared with 67 females. In the over 21 age group (mainly parents and volunteers) the situation was reversed with 72 females and 42 males.

Membership breakdown is shown on a separate page along with a comparison with last season. The total registrations for each of our main activities Swimming, Diving, and Water Polo are shown. There is then a 'netting' factor to take account of members who have registered in more than one activity. For example, 5 swimmers also registered as water polo players.

208 members renewed their membership, 60 new members joined, 88 did not renew membership, and 5 transferred out during the season.
