Swimming Report

I write to you where we ended last year and that unfortunately is, in another lockdown. Although the last year has been extremely challenging for our club and particularly for our swimmers, with months of missed training, cancelled competitions and even being barred from travelling interstate to compete, I want to commend the parents, swimmers and coaches who have endured through the obstacles and stuck with swimming at DVE. By doing this, it has given the kids a sense of belonging to a great club, participating in a sport that keeps them physically and mentally fit and an opportunity to spend time with friends outside school that they can train with and catchup. It's also been great to see more and more parents at training and helping at our meets to make the club better.

At the start of the year, at the height of the COVID pandemic, we started with only 62 swimmers and we currently have 72 swimmers. Our goal has been to get back to pre COVID numbers and there was a big membership drive during the summer which was successful and we had some great new young swimmers join. Although it only shows an increase of 10, it's been a lot more than that when you take into count the swimmers who have left.

I'd like to thank the amazing swimming sub-committee that kept swimming going, from our fearless leader Heather Zipsin, our competitions team Kate, Diana and Michelle who put on a couple great DVE meets and we look forward to the next ones. This role is so big we need 3 people to do it so thank you very much. Angelina who manages new memberships and is usually the first person new members interact with, Kim who's done a great job on social media and behind the scenes that keep the club functioning are Quan Chi, Nicole Rettke, Veronica Basile and Kasey Lawrence.

This year unfortunately, we had to reduce the size of our coaching team. Leading the coaches was our decorated national coach Brian Miller, who also travelled to QLD to coach our National representatives and is a great mentor to the kids, Adelle Bothma who coached our State squad with some great swimmers being developed, Suzi Dowsett with her great rapport with young swimmers coached the Progressive squad and we welcomed a new coach in Monique Bothma who has proven to be a great coach to the young kids as well.

I would also like to give a big shout out to our amazing officials, especially Bob Oldfield who does a great job helping to organise and run our DVE meets, with the help of Lindsay Ellis, Ken Houghton and Deb Kinder.

The dryland program run by Adam and his team of coaches at AV High Performance Academy, has been a wonderful addition to the program and we thank him for his commitment to the kid's before, during and after the lockdown period. With the dryland program moving back to Greensborough we hope that will grow.

Registrar's Report

Given the disruption to aquatic activities caused by the Covid-19 virus for a large part of the 2020/21 season, club registrations were only slightly down from the previous season. A total of 291 members registered across all disciplines a reduction of only 13 from the previous season. Swimming membership showed the largest reduction with 13 fewer competitors and 5 fewer Dry members registering. It was pleasing to see that both Diving and Water Polo registrations increased by 4 and 2 registrations respectively compared with the previous season.

The total number of members in the 12 and under age group matched those in the 13 to 17 years. However, whilst the numbers were evenly matched between boys and girls at under 12 level, the number of girls far outnumbered boys in the 13 to 17 years age group.

Membership breakdown is shown on a separate page along with a comparison with last season. The total registrations for each of our main activities Swimming, Diving, and Water Polo are shown. There is then a 'netting' factor to take account of members who have registered in more than one activity. For example 9 swimmers also registered as water polo players.

207 members renewed their membership, 84 new members joined, and 97 did not renew membership or transferred.
