DVE is no exception and we have had to make tough decisions around how we do things in order to meet Government imposed restrictions, Swimming Victoria and SAL guidelines, and also to maintain financial viability in the face of no income opportunities.

Congratulations to all swimmers who were named as MN Age and Open Champions and most improved swimmers in the 9/U age group at the Metro North AGM last month. DVE was named the District's premier club having won both the A and B Grade Aggregate series. Congratulations also to our National team with a special mention of Zoe Basile and Cameron Mcleod who achieved their first National Qualifying times during the year. Sadly no one could compete due to the event being cancelled.

Congratulations also to Tara Kinder for her selection onto the Junior World Championship Team.

Thank you to the swimming subcommittee for their efforts over the season - Anne Maree, Heather, Michelle, Suzi, Irene, Paul, Brian and Deb. Also, a huge thankyou to the coaching team of Adele, Isobel, Lachlan and Suzi who together with Brian, devoted so much time to the kids and their swimming development during the first half of the season while we could still operate as normal. We look forward to seeing you back on pool deck when the time comes.

The dryland program run by Adam and his team of coaches at AV High Performance Academy, has been a wonderful addition to the program and we thank him for his commitment to the kid's before, during and after the lockdown period. Also, thank you to Jessica Adams for continuing to provide online Pilates to our swimmers.

Thank you to all members who have continued to support the club through these tough and uncertain times. Eventually we will return to a full squad program and your ongoing support will ensure we remain strong and resilient and able to withstand the current situation. DVE is only as strong as its' membership and we are relying on you to support us now more than ever as we navigate our way through this difficult time. While it is normal to lose a few members at the end of each season, sadly this year we have lost more than the usual number. This is a sad reality for many sporting clubs and associations as the current economic situation hits home and families need to reassess their circumstances and priorities. Some families who chose not to renew their registration at the current time, have indicated they will return when life returns to normal.

Current squad numbers are 62.

While it is very easy to dwell on the negatives of the COVID impact and what we have lost as a competitive swimming program, I choose to look at the positives and the opportunities this can present. Now there is time for sub committees and the executive to take stock. To reassess where the club is heading and where it wants to be in 3-5 years' time. To implement change where necessary and to emerge from the current circumstances re-energised so that we can once again grow to be a strong and dominant club.



This will be my final report as VP Swimming as I resigned the position in February due to health reasons. I wish the incumbent all the best as they steer the swimming division of the club forward with new ideas and a fresh approach. Overall, I have had 17 years involvement with swimming clubs and their committees and have been part of DVE since its conception. It has been a privilege and in the most part, a very fulfilling journey.

Registrar's Report

Club registrations for the year showed a very slight decrease compared with the previous season with total membership reducing by just 2. The main reduction was amongst swimming members with registrations down by 16. Divers and Water Polo players each reduced by 2 members each. This was compensated by the increase in swimming 'Dry' members due to the new policy of Swimming Australia which required all swimmers under 18 to have a parent/guardian registered, an approach the club has encouraged for many years. Officials, Life Members, and Non swimmers were all grouped as Dry members.

There was hardly any change in the age group membership with the most significant change in the 13 to 17 age females which reduced by 8. Overall female membership reduced by 10 whilst male membership increased by 8.

A really special mention must go to Joy and Lindsay Ellis who have completed 50 years of continuous membership this season. A really outstanding contribution especially as Lindsay is still an active participant in swimming and officiating.

Membership breakdown is shown below along with a comparison with last season. The total registrations for each of our main activities Swimming, Diving, and Water Polo are shown. There is then a 'netting' factor to take account of members who have registered in more than one activity. For example 15 swimmers also registered as water polo players.

220 members renewed their membership, 84 new members joined, and 91 did not renew membership.



Financial Report

I would like to begin by expressing my thanks to following people for supporting the financial processes of the club:

- Sharon Jones Invoicing Swimming and Diving
- Jamie Osland Invoicing Water Polo

- Leanne Giannios and Pat Southwell BAS and Help Desk (for me).

The final financial statements for DVE Aquatic Club Inc. (ABN: 75 230 366 872) for the financial year ended 30 June 2020 are attached. These have been submitted for an independent financial audit by MFG Tax and Accounting.

When reviewing figures, consideration should be given to the significant impact that the COVID-19 pandemic has had on our club. Over all, the club as experienced a loss of \$13,220.16.

Swimming showed a deficit of \$25,777. Factors impacting the financial position of our swimming discipline include contractual obligations/good will on termination of coaching contracts due to COVID-19, the loss of profit from cancelled swim meets and the absence of fundraisers such as the Swim-a-thon.

It should be noted that despite the loss, this is an improvement on last financial year and had we not been subject to some extraordinary circumstances, figures would show swimming's financial position moving in to a more positive direction.

For the short time that swim squads were back in the pool, fee's moved to a user-pay system. This was an effect method in covering the squad expenses during what was a short 4 – 5 week period.

Water Polo and Diving fee structure covered operating expenses of these disciplines with Water Polo \$3,428 and Diving \$143 in the black.

The club had a positive cash position at 30th June 2020 with a net cash balance of \$27,544.10 and is able to meet all expense and liability payments.

During the year the club has been successful in securing a number of grants. Telstra Kids grant \$1,200.00 These funds will go towards providing support and training for juniors to compete in the state level swimming competitions. Huge thanks to Kate and Roger Liang for applying for the funding for us. Also, the club was successful in its application for the \$1,200.00 Community Sport Sector Short-term Survival Grant. This grant is a State Govt initiative to support the operational viability of community sport and active organisations impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.
