Information and Conditions

1. Conducted under the rules of Swim Vic Inc. This meet will be conducted under the 'one start' rule.
2. The age of the competitor shall be as of the 3rd December 2022.
3. Entry to the pool is free for all swimmers and spectators.
4. On the day late entries will **NOT** be accepted.
5. Please note the Swimming Victoria 11&Under race suit rule will be applied at this meet (please refer to the policy here: <https://vic.swimming.org.au/news-articles/swimming-victoria-11-under-swimsuit-policy-update>)
6. Warm-up up will commence at 12.00pm, with competition commencing at 12.40pm.
7. Session 2 will commence approximately 30 minutes after the completion of session 1.
8. All events will be swum as times finals.
9. **Medals** will be awarded as follows:
 - a. **Session 1** in the following age groups: 8/U, 9-10, 11-12
 - b. **Session 2** in the following age groups: 13-14, 15/O
 - c. **all OPEN events (session 1 & 2)** in the following age groups: 8/U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15/O
10. DVE Aquatic Club reserves the right to cancel, alter or combine events at the discretion of the Meet Director.
11. Self-marshalling will be in place for this meet. Swimmers will self-marshal at least three heats prior to their race. Swimmers to keep themselves informed of event marshalling on the event marshalling board. It is advised that swimmers know their event, heat and lane number prior to marshalling.
12. Backstroke ledges will **NOT** be in use.
13. Note that assistance in timekeeping may be required.
14. Athletes that withdraw from events for any reason will **NOT** be reimbursed entry fees.
15. Application will be made for this meet to be a qualifying meet.
16. Program and timeline will be made available at www.dveaquatic.swimming.org.au from Thursday 1st December 2022.
17. Please be mindful that our Technical Officials need space around the pool to undertake their work and ample clearance must be afforded them on pool deck.

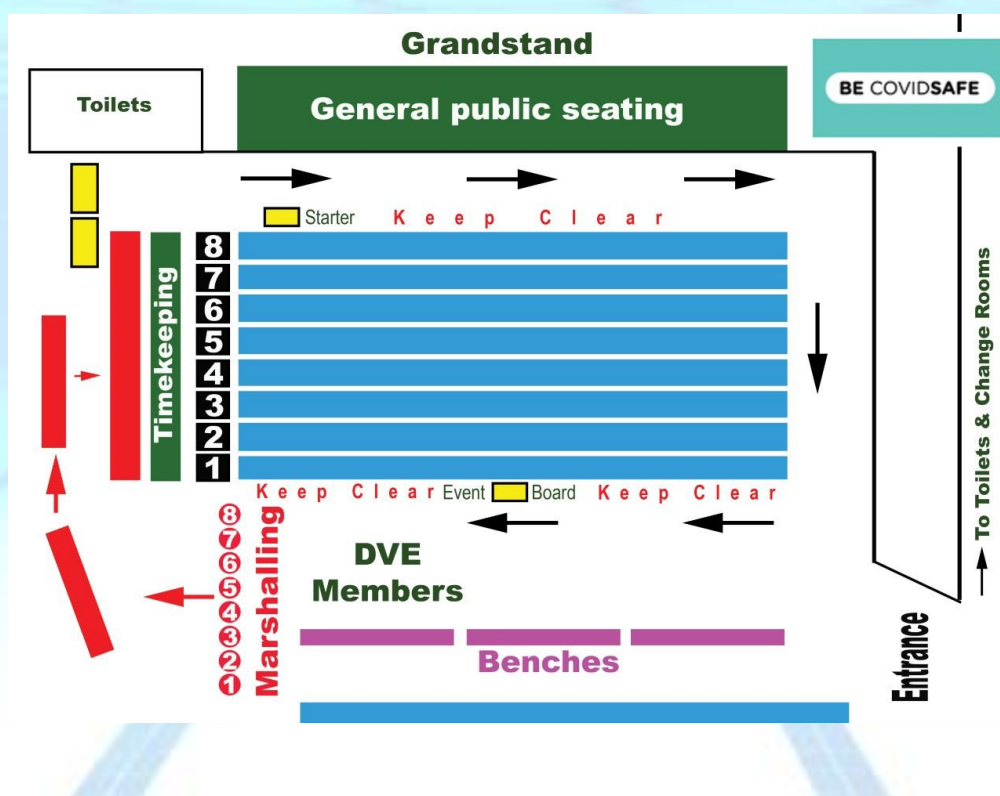
